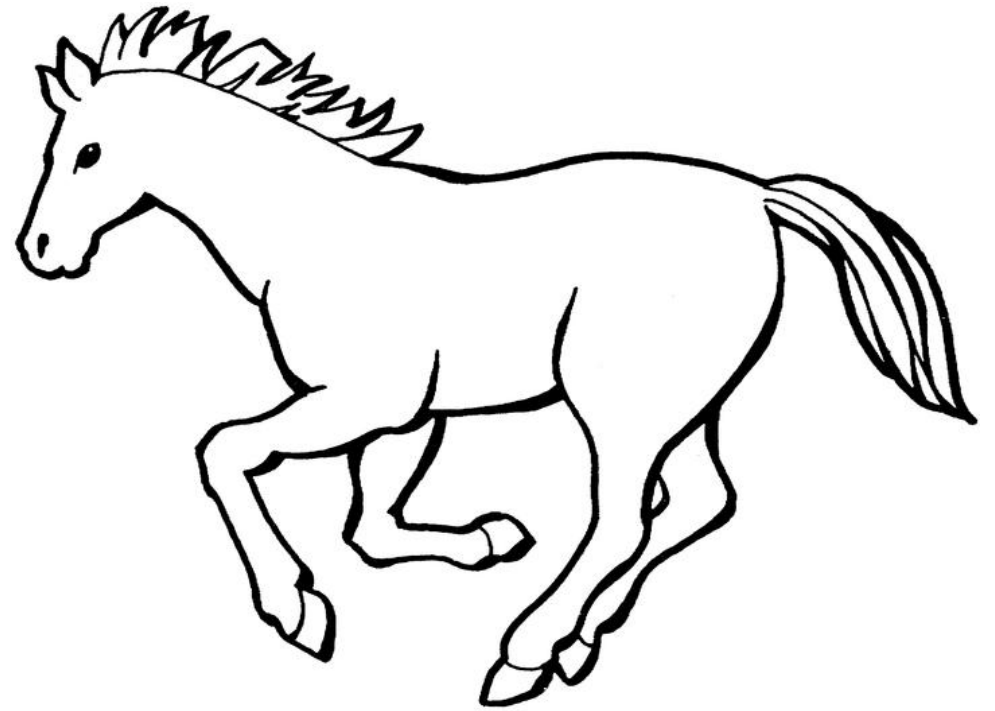


# Wild Pony!



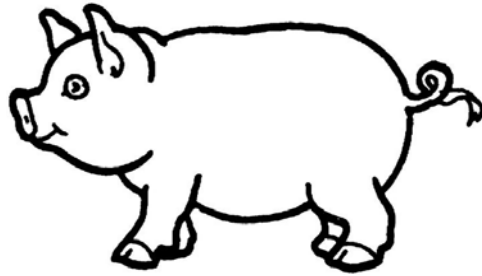
